Conditional Use Permits approved by the Michigamme Township Planning Commission are valid only for the use described in this application. An expansion or change in use of an operation not specifically approved by the commission will require additional hearings. All conditional use permits must adhere to all requirements of section 701 thru 705.

Public Hearings are required for all Conditional Use Permits. Property owners within 300' of the site are notified and a notice is posted in the newspaper at least 15 days prior to the hearing. Petitioners are encouraged to attend the public hearing to answer questions pertaining to the requested permit.

If action is not taken by the applicant to implement the Conditional Use granted by the commission within a one year period, said permit will expire.

All support materials must be submitted to the Planning Commission 22 business days prior to the date of the public hearing.

Please attach a Site Plan (as per section 601 thru 606) of the lot showing the dwelling, accessory structures and available parking. Also, include an interior floor plan indicating the location and square footage of the area used in conjunction with the permit requested. Explain briefly, the Conditional Use Permit requested, the nature of the business and number of employees.

In permitting a Conditional Use, the commission may prescribe certain conditions and safeguards. Violations of any of the required conditions made part of the approval shall be deemed a violation of the Zoning Ordinance and punishable under section 1204. Permits issued under the basis of false information shall be void.

Prior to the Public Hearing, Planning Commissioners may choose to make an on-site inspection.

Any Conditional Use permit may be reviewed at the discretion of the commission. A Public Hearing shall be held prior to the alteration or of conditions or revocation of a permit.
