- IX. ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER COMMENT- Joleen was hired in September 2023 for 5 hours a month. It was increased to 20 hours a month. She only worked 3

weeks. She has dealt with 2 infractions this month which were resolved to the Township's satisfaction. She has read through the State Acts, Administrative procedures and Majastry handbook researching civil infractions. Presently, she has no one to ask questions on what ordinances are civil infractions and what ordinances are municipal civil infractions. Municipal civil infractions are for the State to deal with. She found that the Township didn't have the authority for infractions. It has to be a police department such as the Sheriff Department in our area or a Township Manager to implement civil infractions.

Michigamme needs policies and procedures for their ordinances. Michigamme policies need to be defined in the administrative process to go to the courts. Presently, Joleen doesn't have them. It's advised that we are in need of a Township Administrator, rather than Administrator Assistant. There would be more duties. Presently, no one is assigned the responsibilities for policies and procedures for the ordinances.
